Data processing of particulars in relation to industrial accidents and near incidents

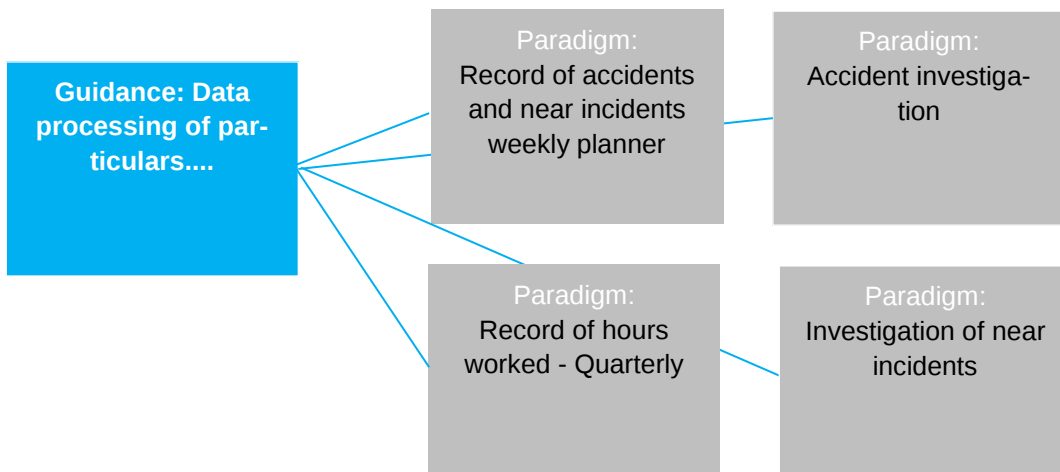
In connection with the implementation of the project “DRD – workplaces without accidents” the Danish Road Directorate needs to collect data about the industrial accidents and near incidents that may occur at the Danish Road Directorate’s construction sites. As Client, we are duty-bound to the overall framework for health and safety on the construction sites, and, at the same time, we wish to support “the good health and safety environment”. In order to be able to identify causes and, subsequently, to target efforts as well as focus areas, the Danish Road Directorate needs to collect data from i.a. industrial accidents and near incidents.

Data will be applied to internal accident statistics, and, externally, data could be incorporated into the final reporting of health and safety to other parties. In external contexts, data will be anonymised so any company particulars being identifiable shall not appear.

The paradigms for [Records of accidents and near incidents](#), [Accident investigation](#), as well as [Investigation of near incidents](#), respectively, have been prepared according to regulations that apply to GDPR.
